WHICH PROGRAMME IS RIGHT FOR ME?

ERASMUS for STUDY

If my primary aim is to spend a semester / full year at a European University to immerse in their didactics and sit for examinations

ERASMUS for TRAINEESHIP

If my objective is to do an internship in a European company / research lab / institution

NON-EU EXCHANGE PROGRAMME («ExtraUE»)

If my goal is to experience a research or internship outside Europe

DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMME (EU / non EU countries)

If I am determined to get a double master's degree, valid in Italy and in a partner country, following a joint programme devised by the two universities in conjunction with one another.



HOW LONG CAN I STAY ABROAD?

ERASMUS for STUDY

Minimum: 3 months - Maximum: depending on the Bilateral Agreement between the University of Milano-Bicocca and the different partner universities (see the list of destinations for more detail)

ERASMUS for TRAINEESHIP

Minimum: 2 months

NON-EU EXCHANGE PROGRAMME («ExtraUE»)

Minimum: 1 month

DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMME (EU / non EU countries)

Minimum: 6 months

! You are allowed to a maximum of 12 months' mobility for each study cycle (I cycle: Degree; II cycle: Master's Degree; III cycle: Doctorate / Specialization Schools). For single-cycle master's degree courses, the maximum total is 24 months of European mobility

DO I GET ANY SCHOLARSHIP?

Students on exchange programmes are entitled to a EU grant and/or a University grant. The amount varies according to the specific programme.

ERASMUS for STUDY and ERASMUS for TRAINEESHIP

A EU grant whose amout depends on the host country's cost of living plus a university top-up proportional to the student's economic situation («ISEE»)

NON-EU PROGRAMMES

A University grant depending on the student's economic situation («ISEE»)

The amount of the EU and university grants will be communicated later.

15th February, 2021

ERASMUS for STUDY, ERASMUS for TRAINEESHIP and NON-EU EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

11th – 29th January, 2021 (before 12h00)

NON-EU DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMME

WHICH ARE THE PREREQUISITES TO APPLY?

You must be enrolled full-time within the normal duration of the course of study ("in corso") to a Degree Course, Master's Degree or Single-cycle Master's Degree, to a School of Specialization or to a PhD. Part-time students and students with a suspended or interrupted career cannot be admitted.

A minimum B2 (CEFR) level of competence in English – or in the language of the host country – or in the working language in case of traineeship - is required.

! The host institution may request a higher level of competence.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Application to be submitted via «Segreterie online»

You are requested to prepare and upload a provisional exchange study/traineeship plan.

Specific procedures and deadlines vary according to the programme you wish to apply for, and are detailed in the respective calls.



ERASMUS FOR STUDY

Erasmus for study is mainly meant to attend courses, but can include a period of curricular internship and the thesis research (please check terms and conditions on the call)

Specific requirements:

An average of 5 ECTS (cfu)/month to be acquired during the mobility.

Minimum 12 ECTS (total) to be entitled to the Erasmus grant.

To apply, a **Progetto di mobilità** must be submitted with up to 5 options for host universities, with a provisional study plan for each of them – see template at: https://www.unimib.it/internazionalizzazione/erasmus-studio/selezioni-erasmus-studio

The Progetto di mobilità must be carefully thought, taking into account the real feasibility of an exchange experience by exploring the academic offer of the envisaged destinations and comparing it with the exams in your curriculum in terms of programmes and workload (ECTS).

An accurate, balanced study plan (total ECTS abroad vs. total ECTS in Bicocca) will give more chances to be selected.

ERASMUS FOR STUDY

A first screening of candidates will be made according to their academic career: number of examinations passed, average mark and ECTS

The Mobility Coordinators will then evaluate the «Progetto di mobilità» and can ask candidates to sit for an interview for further evaluation.

Students will be assigned a destination according to their position in the merit ranking («graduatoria») and have to accept (confirm) or decline it.

Students who refuse a destination they had chosen will not be entitled to any other option.

Destinations not accepted are reallocated if necessary (when the number of students admitted exceeds the places availables for the specific course/Department).

The final «graduatoria» with the definitive destination will be published on 8th March, 2021 Students who should retire after 8th March, 2021 will be subject to a fine of € 200.
