## *Background*

Elisabetta Ruspini is full Professor of Sociology at the University of Milano-Bicocca, Milan, Italy. She holds a PhD in Sociology and Social Research from the University of Trento (1997).

Since the start of her academic life she has devoted a considerable amount of time to studying the relationship between gender and social change: women's poverty and social exclusion, the social construction of gender identities as a dynamic process; the interplay between gender, family formation and parenting roles; the relationship between gender and the generational turnover (particularly Millennials and Gen Zers); the future of gender research. This from both a theoretical and a methodological point of view. Her interest in the relationship between gender and social change arose out of research done for a PhD thesis in Sociology and Social Research (University of Trento, 1994-1997). The thesis was based on data from two household panel surveys (*GSOEP-German Socio-Economic Panel* and *BHPS-British Household Panel Survey*), and focused on the gender dimension of poverty in Germany and Great Britain. Methodological reflections on longitudinal data were further developed during post-doctorate research carried out at both the University of Essex-European Centre for Analysis in the Social Sciences (ECASS programme) and the Universities of Mannheim and Goteborg - as part of the *Training and Mobility of Researchers* programme set up by the European Community within the 'Family and the Welfare State in Europe' TMR research programme for young researchers. The aim of the research project carried out – "Family, Gender and Dynamics of Poverty in Different Welfare States" – was to focus on the circumstances that explain the dynamics of lone mothers' poverty in five different European settings: Belgium, (West) Germany, Great Britain, Italy and Sweden using household panel

data. Her interest in longitudinal research increased during a period spent as an international visiting fellow in Social Research Methods at the University of Surrey, Department of Sociology, School of Human Sciences.

She has relevant expertise in Gender Studies (both Women's Studies and Men and Masculinity Studies), Gender Relations in Society, Sociology of Families, Generational Studies (Millennials and Gen Zers) and LGBT Studies, as well as in gender-sensitive research and on how to strengthen the gender dimension of both social research and research programs in order to remove gender imbalances. She has functioned as a gender expert and adviser for diverse research stakeholders in Italy and Europe (European Community), and has been actively involved in developing gender-sensitive approaches in Universities and Associations.

She has extensive teaching and research experience on Feminist, Women's and Gender Studies, Family and Generational issues. She has published a relevant number of books (authored books and edited books/journal issues), articles and contributed papers to several national and international conferences/seminars/workshops in these fields.
