

PUBLIC INTERNATIONAL LAW (ADVANCED COURSE)

The course deals with a specific aspect of international human rights protection, namely what are the rights of migrants by sea, including illegal migrants and asylum seekers.

The relevant documents and an article will be distributed (T. Scovazzi, Human Rights and Immigration at Sea) during the classes.

Students should attend the classes, as they are expected to actively intervene in the discussions (in English). They should already have a basic knowledge of international law.

The exam will be oral.

Tullio Scovazzi is professor of International law at the Law Faculty of the University of Milano-Bicocca, Milan, Italy. He occasionally participates, as legal advisor of Italy, to international negotiations and meetings relating to law of the sea, law of the environment, cultural properties and human rights.
