The requests must be received no later than 12:00 on May 20th, 2017. Applications received after the date will not be considered.

The Commission can assign up to 100 points according to the following criteria:

Up to 50 points for the qualifications and experience resulting from Curriculum Vitae;


Up to 30 points for the evaluation of the motivational letter;

Up to 20 points for the evaluation of the language skills reported on the CV by each candidate;

In order to be considered eligible candidates must reach an overall score of at least 60. Up to the same score, priority will be given to younger students.
