

Italian classes for visiting students, Erasmus, a.y. 2026/27 I sem.

The University of Milano-Bicocca offers 50-hour Italian classes to Erasmus students who need / want to improve the language.

All **Erasmus students** must complete the compulsory questionnaire on Italian courses, even though they will not take the course.

We remind you that the course is compulsory if you do not have a **B1 certification of Italian** or a **B2 certification of English**.

ENTRY TEST DATES

Fall semester: The test will take place from remote on **July 15th, 2026**

The hour of the test will be communicated directly to the students at least 48 hours before the test.

A welcome meeting to explain the modalities of the test will precede entry tests.

Depending on the results of the entry test, students will be assigned and enrolled in the most suitable class.

Some classes (Pre A2, A2, and PreB1) may be not arranged for lack of students.

Results, classes and class timetables will be posted on this web site by the day before the start of the Italian courses.

ITALIAN CLASSES

Fall semester Italian classes begin on Aug. 27th, 2026 from remote. Courses will proceed in-person on Sept. 9th. It is mandatory to be in Milan by Sept. 9th to complete the course in-person.

The schedules of the courses will be sent to students at least one day before the beginning of the course.

FINAL TEST

Students will be allowed to take the final assessment test with the teacher only if they attended at least the 75% of all the lessons.

Students who pass the final test and have entered the code ITAERA1 in their Learning agreement will obtain **3 ECTS** in their TOR and receive an email to their @campus.unimib.it account with the instructions to get the **Open badge**. The Open Badge is a digital certification issued by Bicocca University, whose link can be inserted in your c.v. and can be accepted by public and private institutions as an additional activity.

If students pass the final test but have not entered the code ITAERA1 in their Learning agreement, they will receive only an email to @campus.unimib.it with the instructions to get the **Open badge** certificate.
