Call for Applications to Become a Tutor for the Bicocca Bridge Service – For a Plural University

Dear students,

The "**Bicocca Bridge – for a plural University**" service is active at Bicocca. Applications are open for **4 positions** reserved for students with a proven interest in intercultural issues and orientation. The selected individuals will carry out collaboration and support activities within the Service. Specifically, tutors will work to achieve the following goals:

- Peer-to-peer support in building social networks for active participation in academic life;
- Organization of meetings/webinars on intercultural topics;
- Dissemination of information regarding the service and its activities;
- Support in the organization and implementation of institutional activities (e.g., Open Days);
- Support in the organization of orientation workshops for prospective students (in schools) and current students (at the university);
- Monitoring and documentation of the service's activities.

Below are the number of hours to be completed **between October 2026 and June 30, 2027**, the hourly wage (gross company cost), and the total compensation (gross company cost) per individual tutor.

The admission requirements, evaluation criteria, and the procedure for submitting applications are indicated below.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students of the University of Milano-Bicocca who, by the deadline for submitting applications to participate in the selection process, satisfy one of the following requirements may apply for admission:

1. enrolled in a Master's degree course (*laurea magistrale*) in the academic year 2026/27;
2. enrolled in the 4th or 5th year of a single-cycle Master's degree course in the academic year 2026/27;

3. enrolled in a Bachelor's degree course or in the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd year of a single-cycle Master's degree course in the academic year 2026/27, provided they have already obtained a university degree;
4. enrolled in a PhD course in the academic year 2026/27.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will evaluate, at its sole discretion, the candidate's **qualifications**:

- Specific training in intercultural fields and orientation (for incoming and current students);
- Experience in study support and/or orientation gained in intercultural contexts;
- Educational experience within projects aimed at youth, in university and/or extra-university contexts.

Applications will also be evaluated based on an **interview**, which will take place online via Webex on **October 08, 2026, at 12:00 PM**. The link to the virtual room will be sent via email to students after the closing of applications.

During the interview, the Selection Committee will evaluate, at its sole discretion:

- Knowledge gained in previous educational or research experiences in intercultural contexts;
- Knowledge related to peer support methodologies and tools, as well as orientation for incoming and current students.

HOW TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION

Participation in the selection process takes place by filling out [this Google form](#), to which the curriculum vitae, motivational letter, and self-certification of enrollment for the academic year 2026/2027 (downloadable from Segreteria Online) must be attached.

Applications must be received **no later than 12:00 PM on October 07, 2026**. The results of the selection will be published on the [web page](#) dedicated to the service.

Selected individuals will be contacted via email by the offices to formalize the contract.
