The Summer School " TOWARDS A BIO-BASED ECONOMY: science, innovation, economics, education " is organized by the University of Milano-Bicocca in cooperation with Chalmers University of Technology (Gothenburg, Sweden).

The course is thought entirely in English and will be held September 3rd-7th 2018 at the University of Milano-Bicocca.

Fondazione Gianni Bassetti will award 2 scholarships to cover the course fees.

The requests must be received no later than 12:00 on May 20th 2018. Uncomplete or late applications will not be considered.

The Committee has at its disposal 100 points to award according to the following criteria:

- Up to 65 points for the qualifications and experience resulting from the evaluation of the Curriculum Vitae.
- Up to 30 points for the evaluation of the motivational letter
- Up to 5 additional points will be granted to applicants with certifications attesting proficiency

In order to be considered eligible candidates must reach an overall mark of no less than 60 points. With the same score, priority will be given to the younger candidate.

The selection list will be published at the Summer School page no later than June 4th 2018
