The Commission has at its disposal 100 points to award according to the following criteria:

Up to 50 points for the qualifications and experience resulting from the evaluation of the Curriculum Vitae. Up to 30 points for the evaluation of the motivational letter

Up to 20 points for the evaluation of language skills indicated by each candidate

In order to be considered eligible candidates must reach an overall mark of no less than 60 points. With the same score, priority will be given to the younger candidate.
