Biography, research interests, and outputs

Graduated in 1998 from the University Blaise Pascal of Clermont-Ferrand (France) with a master in Cognitive Processes & Social Psychology, I completed a Ph.D. in 2003 at the same university. My work was part of the French CNRS National Research Group from which I obtained a junior research officer position from 1998 to 2001. During the last two years of my Ph. D, I was also a full-time lecturer in Psychology at the University of Le Havre (France). After this, I was a research fellow at the Augusta State University (Georgia, USA) from October 2004 to March 2005, at the University of Essex (UK) from October 2005 to June 2007, and from July 2007 to November 2011 at the University of Milan-Bicocca (Italy). I became a Researcher at the University of Milan-Bicocca (Italy) in December 2011.

My main research interests are focused broadly on the study of deliberative and automatic processes involved in social cognition. Within the University of Milan-Bicocca, I am part of the research group PsychoSCoPe (Psychometrics of Social Cognition and Personality, <http://psychoscope.psico.unimib.it>) that focuses on the measurement of implicit and explicit preferences and personality dispositions. Over the years, I investigated several aspects of measures of implicit cognition based on reaction times to cognitive tasks, with a particular interest in predictive validity in different domains, such as food consumption or aggression. I have been a consultant in various projects investigating implicit biases in medical practices. I have also been involved in a series of projects that explore a series of feature transformation effects such as evaluative learning or the halo effects. I also focused on measures of explicit cognition, especially the ones used in attitude and dual models. I have applied and tested various models of decision making in the context of attitude theory and social cognition. I am also part of the research group ECLiPPs (Experimental Clinical & Personality Psychology) that investigates social cognition processes involved in different personality pathologies. Within this research group, I am taking part in research, adopting a dynamical approach to examine the person x situation interaction with a particular angle regarding personality pathology traits. Over the years, I have established various collaborations with psychology colleagues from different countries and scientists from different disciplines (e.g., economics, medicine). From these various research projects, I have published more than 50 articles in international peer-reviewed journals. I am a reviewer for more than 20 international scientific journals. I also have experience in Ph. D. supervision.
