- d. Every year, the University of Milano-Bicocca welcomes around 2,200 international students from all over the world. Of these, around 300 come to Milan on various programmes (Exchange, Erasmus, Double Degree or PhD) for a period of one or two semesters. The majority of the international students are Prospective Students, or students who study for an entire degree course at our university. Of these, around 200 also study at our Summer and Winter School programmes around the world, with destinations including Italy, various European countries and even Kazakhstan, India and China. Every year, the university also welcomes a group of Chinese students as part of the Marco Polo programme. The university's educational offering for international students is split into Bachelor and Master MSc Degrees.

Five of these courses are delivered entirely in English: Applied Experimental Psychological Science, Materials Science, Marine Sciences, International Economics, Medicine and Surgery.

- d. The Specialisation School is a 'postgraduate' university course that aims to train specialists. A fixed number of doctors are admitted to the Healthcare Specialisation Schools. For admission to a Specialisation School, it is necessary to have a degree in medicine and surgery with an obligation to obtain the qualification to practise the profession of doctor/surgeon by the start date of the teaching activities, as well as to pass a national competition based on qualification and test organized annually by the MIUR (Ministry of Education, University and Research). At the end of the training course the Diploma of specialisation in the chosen field is issued. The Healthcare Specialisation Schools encompass the following three areas: Medical Area, Surgical Area and Clinical Services Area. Within the individual areas the Schools are grouped into uniform classes to enable better use of structural, educational and welfare resources, including the activities referred to as the core area

In the late 1980s, the academic bodies of the University of Milan set out a programme designed to obtain new premises to use for innovative research activities in strategic sectors and extend the teaching offering to fields of discipline that were absent from the local public institutions. Through the 1991-93 three-year plan announced by Minister Ruberti, the Ministry of Universities and Scientific Research unveiled plans to split universities with over 40,000 alumni in order to better organise its multi-year development plans and bring about decongestion. The University of Milan – which was identified as one of the large universities in need of decongesting – was authorised to set up additional university hubs in the local urban area. Under the 1993 Budget, Article 3 of Law 498 authorised social security bodies to purchase real estate to lease to universities and public research bodies, using up to 20% of funds available for 1993 and 1994. In September 1993, the Municipality of Milan ruled that the Bicocca area would be the location of the new University of Milan hub.

- d. The University of Milano-Bicocca was established on June 10, 1998, to serve students from Northern Italy and relieve some of the pressure on the over-crowded University of Milan. Groups of professors and researchers chose to come and participate in the enterprise. They were driven by their enthusiasm for the new, and by the chance to broaden academic horizons without having their work undermined by traditional methods of education. From the start, this very fertile climate became a unique training ground, which offered something new even in the most traditional disciplines. The University stands in an area on the northern edge of Milan, which was occupied by the Pirelli industrial complex until the late 1980s. This area is now the location of the biggest urban renewal project carried out in Milan since the end of the Second World War. The world renowned architect, Vittorio Gregotti has transformed the ex-industrial area and its warehouses into a new district, which includes our Athenaeum, research laboratories and student residence halls; Hangar Bicocca, the

contemporary art museum; the Italian National Research Council (CNR), multinational company offices and the new headquarters of the Pirelli Group.

- d. The School of Medicine is located in our Monza campus next to San Gerardo Hospital. The school's close relationship with the hospital clinics and its physician/instructors give students hands-on experience with the diagnostic and therapeutic procedures of patient care. Other hospitals and clinics such as "Aziende Ospedaliere" in Vimercate, Lecco, Sondrio and Bergamo are also linked to the university and offer our students internship opportunities that complement their courses of study. The School of Educational Sciences offers theoretical and practical preparation at various levels of education, intercultural communication and pedagogical consulting. Our School has developed a unique and innovative trans-disciplinary method for conducting clinical, empirical, theoretical and applied research founded on the interaction of various bases of knowledge: pedagogical, philosophical, anthropological, psychological, sociological and historic, among others.
